Scope of Work: This project will construct a 5,550 linear foot extension of water main, 7,800 linear foot sewer extension from the north of the property, and a 1,350 linear foot extension from the west of the property all of which are necessary to address critical water and wastewater need of the adjacent area. See attached map. Engineer services will include planning, design, and construction administration services for the project. Engineer may be required to make presentations to OIA and other public entities.

The estimated cost of construction is \$7,500,000.

Construction must be complete prior to December 2024.


